Finished Size: Approx. 6" x 9"

Materials

1 Skein worsted weight. Approx 120 yards.
Pictured is a cotton/wool blend.

Alternates yarns: Mercerized cotton or Wool.
(Really anything worsted in your stash should work fine since you're lining it.)

US 7 (4.5 mm) needles. Strait or circular.

US 10 (6mm) needles. Strait or circular.

Fabric for lining.

Tapestry needle

Needle and thread for lining.

Handle of choice.

Gauge

Come on you perfectionists! It's a purse.

Take a deep breath and let it go...

Purse Directions:

Using your Size US 10 needles and Long Tale Cast On, CO 84 stitches.

Row 2-14

Turn work and continue knitting in Garter stitch for 14 rows. (15 total with cast on row)

Row 15

(K3tog, K1) to end of row. 42 stitches total.
Swap to Size US 7 needles.

Cont. in Garter until entire piece *including ruffle* measures 14" and Cast off all stitches.
Fold cast off edge to 1/2" from base of ruffle.
Seam left and right side of purse. Turn right side out.

Lining Directions:

Fold fabric wrong side facing out.

Measure folded fabric to size of purse. Add 1/4" seam allowance to left and right side and top. Cut lining.



Sew left and right side of lining.
Fold and steam down top of lining 1/4".

This is now a pocket that you slide into the purse. Stitch lining in at top of purse. *see picture below.
Add a handle and fini! Go crazy with buttons and other embellishments. anything that makes it you!
